Our Expectations

- Never offer, promise, give, request, or accept bribes or other improper payments or benefits
- Comply with all applicable anti-bribery and anti-corruption laws and regulations
- Maintain accurate records of all business dealings, expenses, and transactions
- Avoid any activity that could be perceived as an attempt to improperly influence a business decision

Gifts and Hospitality

Any gifts or hospitality offered to or received from SSE employees must be:

- Reasonable in value and infrequent (generally less than £50, reasonable accommodation and travel costs for business only related travel)
- Clearly not intended to secure or reward favourable treatment
- Declared and approved in advance where appropriate

Reporting Concerns

If you become aware of or suspect any form of bribery or corrupt activity, you must report it to the Managing Director of SSE immediately. Any reports will be treated confidentially.
